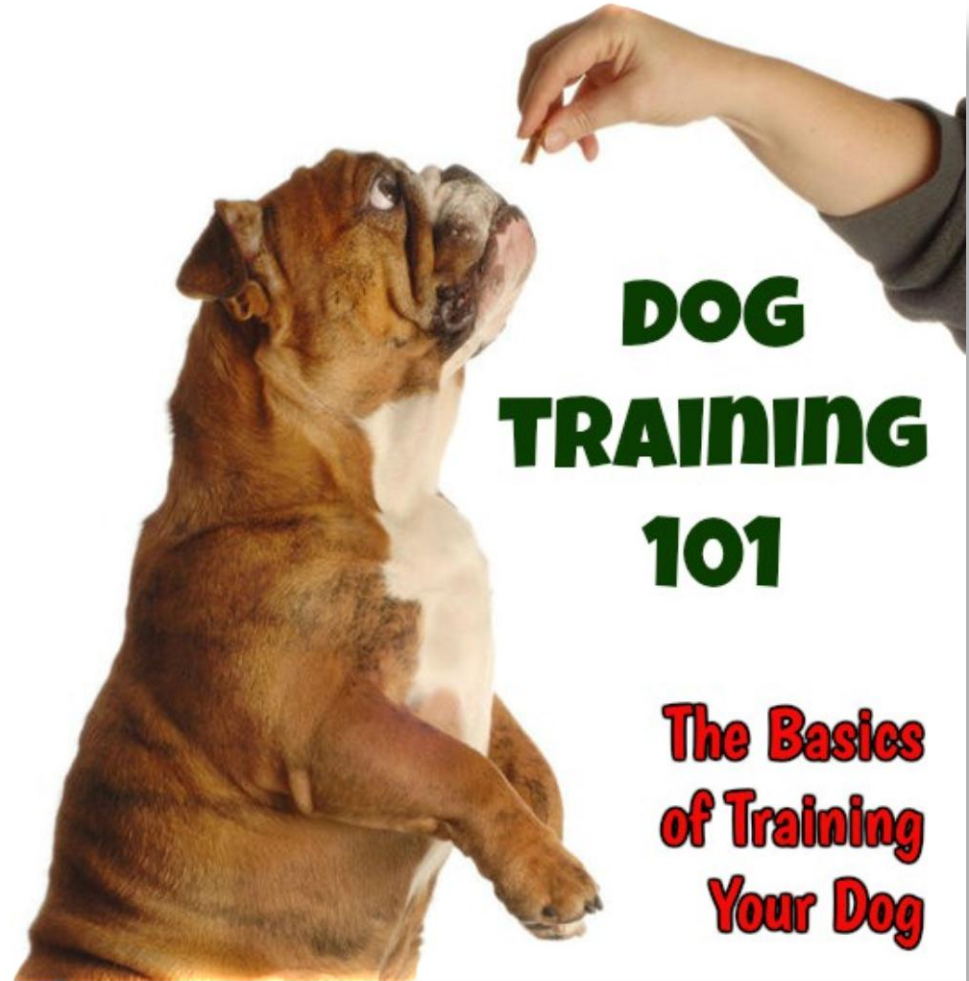

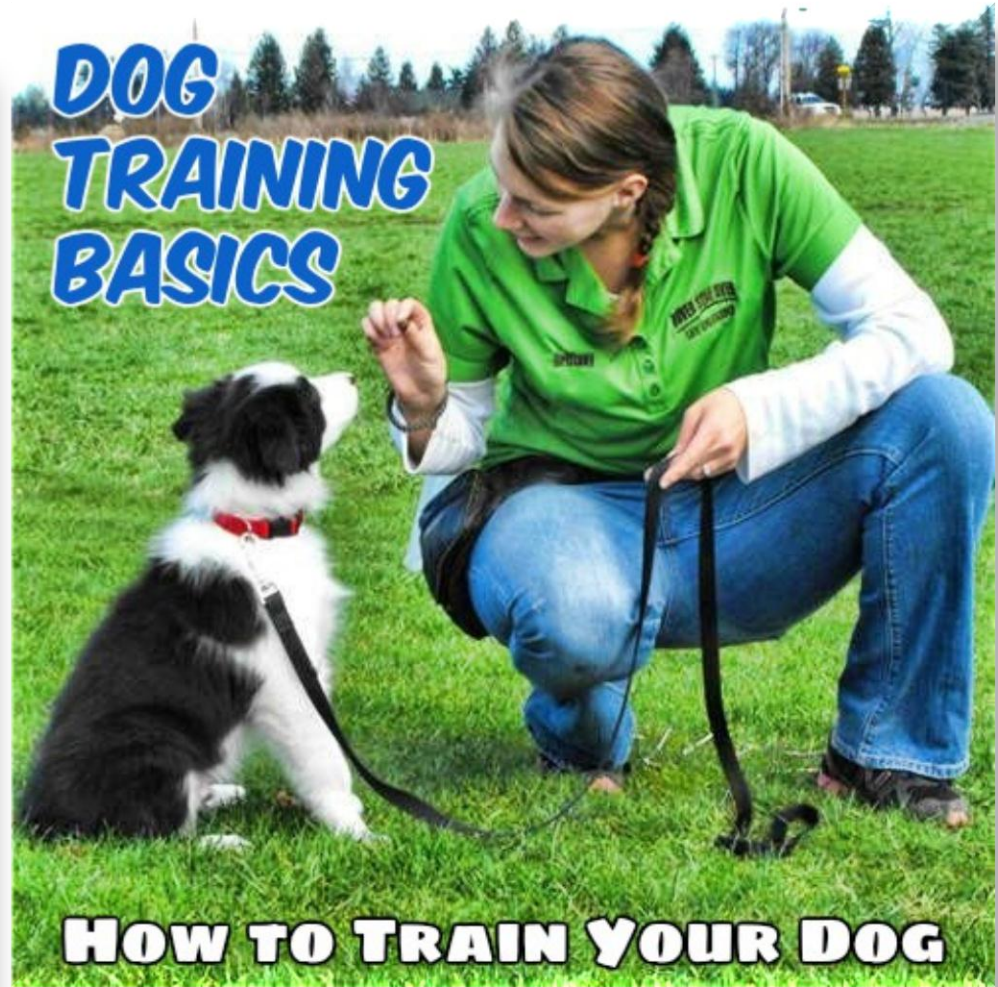

Puppies love to bite. They do it naturally but it is something that they must be taught not to do.

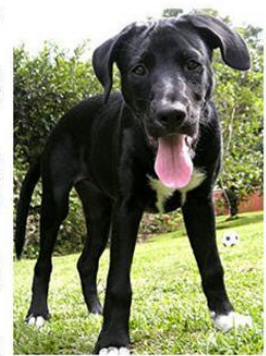
This needs to be addressed while they are young because dog bites can lead to all sorts of problems including legal action.

It may seem fun and funny to have a puppy biting but a full-grown dog can do a lot of damage, particularly to children if they are in the habit of biting.

Dogs have immense strength in their jaws and even a playful nip can do permanent damage to a child.

Generally, puppies are taught to control their biting from their mothers but in most cases we get puppies as pets that have been taken from their mothers at a very young age and it is up to us to teach them as puppies not to bite.

By letting your dog socialize with other dogs from a young age they will quickly learn from their elders, provided they have been taught well, that the desire to bite needs to be curbed to avoid retaliation and an ensuing fight.



CRATE TRAINING

One of the best things you can do for your puppy early in life is crate training. Many people are under the misconception that crate training a puppy is cruel but this is far from the truth.

Dogs actually get a lot of benefit from having been crate trained and they generally come to like the fact that they have been crate trained.

Many people also assume that crate training is difficult, but this is also far from the truth.

Dogs, naturally avoid soiling the area where they will eat and sleep and this is one of the reasons why crate training is important.

ADDRESSING THE PROBLEM OF BOREDOM

This comes back to the basics of dog training where the dog must be aware of who the master is.

Failure to get this basic dog training technique under control can lead to all sorts of problems, particularly if the dog gets off the leash.

In the presence of other dogs, and sometimes young children this problem becomes pronounced.

Many people believe that the lifespan of the dog should be considerably more than what we expect.

Grapes and raisins can cause kidney failure and even a single serving of raisins can kill your dog.

So you have a problem with a whining dog?

It is not unusual for people to have problems, particularly with puppies whining all day long. Most puppies will outgrow this behavior.

They generally whine for two reasons. For attention and when they are anxious.

If they want attention, they will continue to whine if that attention attracts a reward.

It is better just to give your dog attention in the form of eye contact rather than a reward to stop it from whining, as a reward will only encourage it to whine all the more.

Often the best solution is to ignore the dog completely until the whining stops no matter how long it might take. When the dog realizes that it is not getting the reward it expects from whining it will tend to stop.

An alternative method is to blow a whistle when your dog is whining and when it stops you stop. Often this method works faster than simply ignoring it.



WHY IS YOUR DOG BARKING?

There is always a reason why a dog will continue to bark and more often than not it is related to boredom.

Alternatively the dog could be hungry and wanting food or water, or quite possibly they don't have sufficient shelter from the elements whether in a hot or cold climate.

It is always a good idea to have a regular check of your dogs' kennel or cage to ensure there hasn't been any damage that could harm it.

Round worms live in the small intestine of the dog and can become so concentrated that they will block the passage.

DOG TRAINING IS ALL ABOUT BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS

Good dog training is all about building positive relationships where the dog has respect for its owner and also where the dog realizes that the owner is the master and leader of the pack.

If the owner assumes the position of the leader of the pack and the dog knows and respects that position then it will feel more secure and be a happier pet.

Under no circumstances should the dog be fearful of its master and that is why most current methods of dog training focus on the positive aspects of the dogs actions and reward it for the good actions that it takes rather than punishing it for anything that it does wrong.



TEACHING AN OLD DOG NEW TRICKS

It is always a lot easier to teach a puppy the right things to do when they are young, but it is not impossible to eliminate the bad habits of an older dog.

The first step obviously is the need to make sure the dog understands that you are the master so you can gain its respect and then you can start the process of training the dog so that it no longer performs the unwanted actions.

It is important that every dog learns to feel comfortable with a collar and lead, as this will be required when taking the dog to public places.

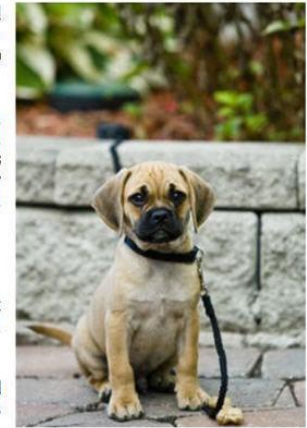

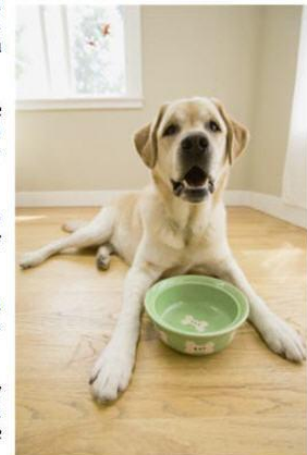
Unless you have no intention of ever being apart from your dog, then it is a wise decision to train it to be happy while you have periods apart.
